They tell us that a helper who can't hear can still check for breathing by watching the chest and stomach rise and fall. If you put your cheek close to the patient's mouth you will be able to feel their warm breath. A mirror near their mouth would mist up too. Since the pandemic, they say that mouth to mouth resuscitation is not recommended. Use chest compressions.
