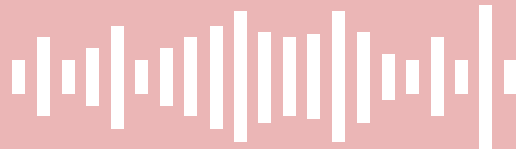


## Our Go-To places – Families
